### Monitoring Transnational Project Meeting - hosted by Poznan University of Technology, Poland on 23rd-24th of February 2022



The third transnational meeting was organized at the University of Poznan February 2022 with the same representatives of the BRIGTH project and basically with the same goals, to monitor the progress of the activities, financial aspects, to communicate changes in rules and regulations imposed by the Romanian National Agency and also to take care about all the technical activities that are required to be realized in the project.

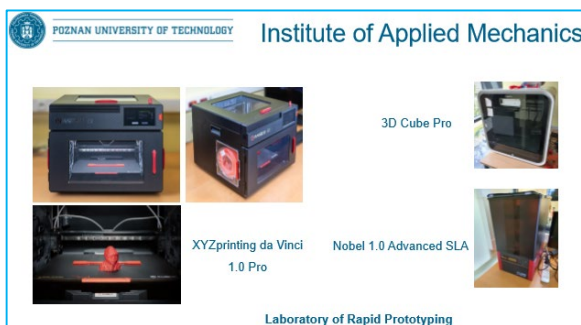
Was presented the plan regarding the project activities in 2022 (Learning Teaching Training, Transnational Project Meetings, Multiplier Events).
